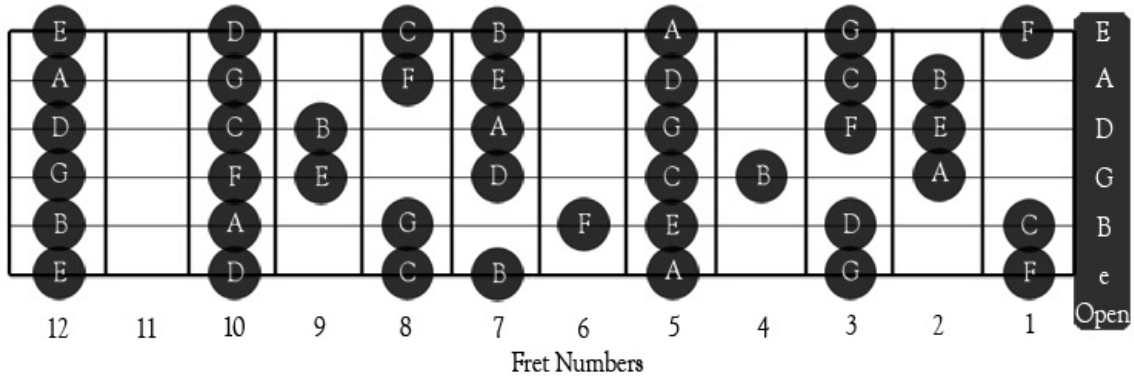


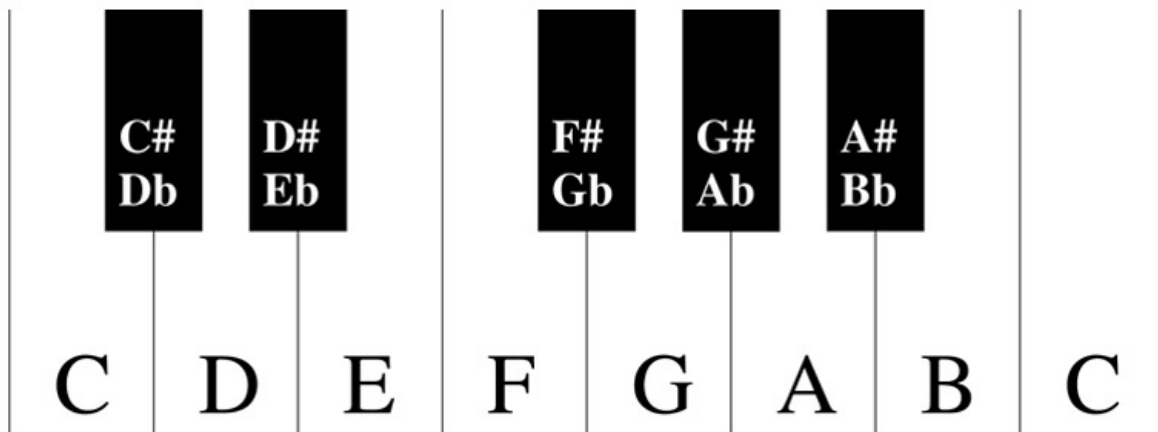
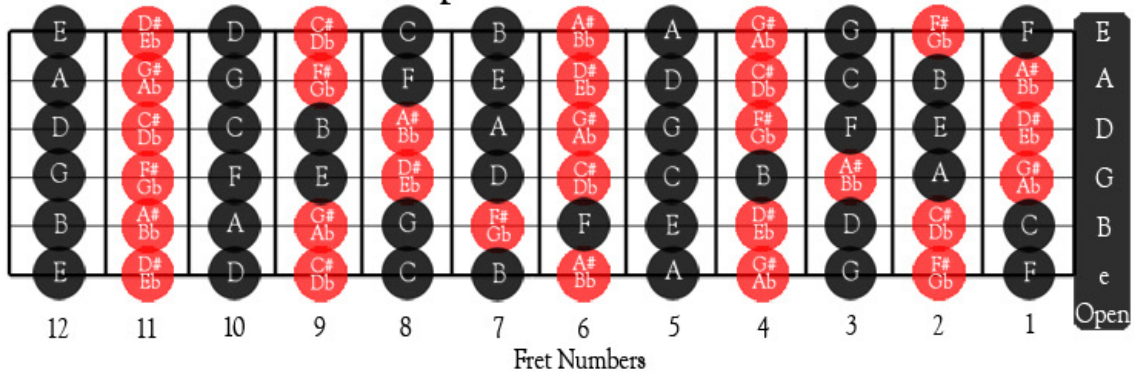

All charts are charted as looking at my guitar neck in the video (a right handed person sitting in front of you). Fret numbers start right and move left, and the smallest string is on the bottom.
